Information for Attendees

1. Location

Workshops and talks will take place in the Alan MacDiarmid, Te Toki a Rata and Cotton buildings at the Kelburn campus, Victoria University of Wellington (accessible through Gate 7 off Kelburn Parade). Registration, morning/afternoon teas and lunches will take place in the main foyer of the Alan MacDiarmid Building, near the café symbol on the map below:



2. Registration

Registration will be open from 8:45am on Thursday morning in the main foyer of the Alan MacDiarmid Building.

3. Parking and getting to Victoria University

There is 120 minute street parking available around the university but this is limited. There is also some limited coupon parking available in Kelburn.

The bus services to the university are very regular. You can catch a number 22 from Wellington Station Stop C (via the Terrace) or there is also a 21 service from Courtenay Place (via Ghuznee Street). Both services run approximately every 10 mins.

There is also a less regular 18 service which runs between Victoria University and Massey Wellington.

When you hop off the bus at Victoria just head up Kelburn Parade to Gate 7.

Just avoid the 91 buses as they cost more. The closest bus stops are stop 5008 (Willis Street at Grand Arcade) if coming from Courtenay Place or stop 5510 (Willis Street at Willbank Court) if coming from the Railway Station.
